Commander

Commander Glenn Sander has been a member of the Ventura County Sheriff's Department for almost 23 years. He is currently assigned to the East County Sheriff's Station overseeing patrol operations for Oak Park and the East County areas adjacent to Thousand Oaks and Simi Valley. He also oversees the Moorpark

Police contract, the Tactical Response Team, the Canine Unit and the Department's Reserve Deputy Program. Glenn's work history includes five assignments in Detention Services as a deputy, senior deputy and sergeant at the Pre-Trial Detention Facility, and as the facility manager (captain) of the Todd Road Jail. Most recently, Glenn completed a two-year assignment in Detention Services Administration managing its \$117 million budget. Glenn's Police Services experience includes patrol assignments in Thousand Oaks, Camarillo and Moorpark, and Investigations in both Camarillo and Moorpark. Glenn also guided the Community Policing Unit for Thousand Oaks and coordinated Crime Prevention efforts in Camarillo. Finally, Glenn worked in Professional Standards as an Internal Affairs investigator, and managed the Inspection and Audits Unit.

Commander Sander received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science from Principia College in Illinois, and his Jurist Doctor degree from Wayne State University in Detroit, Michigan, where he lived prior to joining the Ventura County Sheriff's Department in 1984.

Glenn lives in Camarillo with his wife and two children, recently completing nine years of service to AYSO soccer and CYBA basketball as a coach, referee and administrator.
