Narrative:

On 01/19/05, at about 2:00 p.m., the victim was parked in her vehicle along the Pacific Coast Highway near Deer Creek Road when she was approached by the suspect, who was on foot. The suspect brandished a handgun and ordered the victim to release control of her vehicle to him. The suspect then drove the victim's vehicle and the victim to a remote mountainous area where he sexually assaulted her and robbed her of some personal property. The victim sustained minor injuries during the attack, and she did not require hospitalization.

After sexually assaulting and robbing the victim, the suspect drove off in the victim's vehicle, leaving the victim in the remote area. The victim was later able to successfully hail a passing motorist, who transported her to a safe location where the authorities were notified. The victim's vehicle was later discovered by patrol deputies abandoned in the area of the Pacific Coast Highway at Sycamore Canyon.
